We Can No Longer Accept the Following:

Tires, broken or tempered glass, paint, pianos or organs not in good working order, fiberglass bath tubs and showers, porcelain commodes and sinks, waterbeds, irreparable press board furniture, non-working plastic shelled TVs, console stereos, mobile homes, wet or soiled clothing, and wet, soiled ripped or torn upholstery pieces or bedding.
