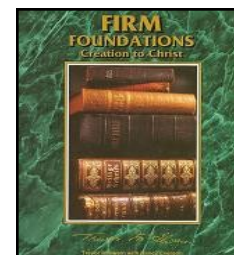

Men's Training Center

The Men's Training Center is a one-year Christ centered and bible based discipleship program structured to build spiritual foundations for the new believer in Jesus Christ. It also provides an atmosphere for life skills training, career assessment, personality testing, job placement, or steps towards educational goals. Men who have successfully graduated are eligible to enter the Haven of Rests transitional housing offering continued accountability and counsel for successful reentry into society. Mentors who are trained by the Haven of Rest provide a bridge to the local church, the life blood for the new believer.



Firm Foundations: Creation To Christ – McIlwain/Everson

Presents a survey of the Bible understandable enough for those with little previous knowledge, while providing a systematic presentation of the salvation message throughout the Old Testament to the resurrection. This study also addresses the question posed in the mind of the student with regards to salvation, 'Have I done it correctly?', and encourages them to ask more rightly, 'Has the Lord Jesus Christ done everything on their behalf correctly to satisfy the Father?'. Rather than focusing on any one part, the survey chronologically explains and blends the Bible's greatest events and themes. Upon completion, the student will find themselves, through the superintending of the Holy Spirit, believing the written word like never before and trusting the **finished work** of the living Word, Christ alone for their salvation.

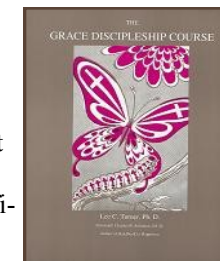

PHASE TWO— 6 Months Building Blocks

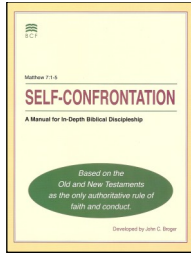
Strings or threads through the scriptures, like a lawyer building his case, was Jesus' the master teachers method for relaying truth.

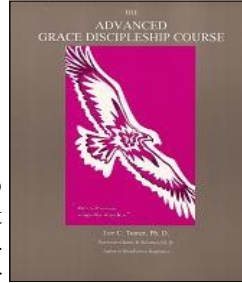

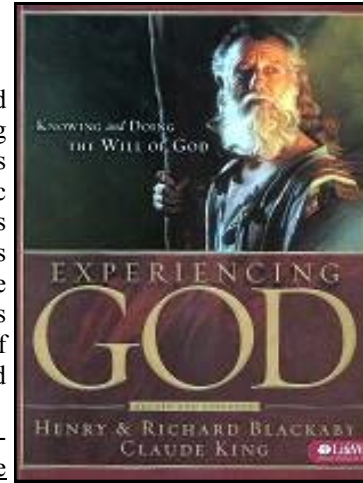
PHASE THREE-3 Months Sanctuaries

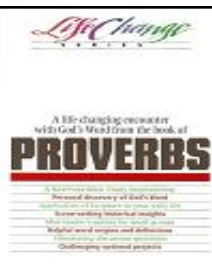
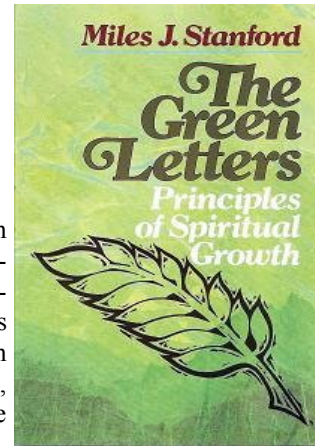

Phase 1-3

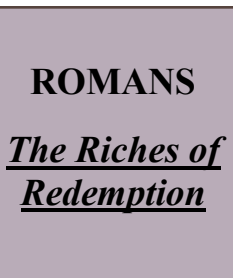
Principles of identification in Christ that reflect dependency on Christ are discussed. These principles can make a difference in progress and frustration, peace or turmoil for the child of God.

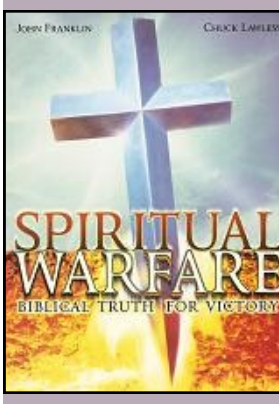

Spiritual Warfare: Biblical Truth For Victory

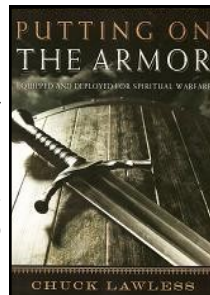
Chuck Lawless
